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Mainstreaming biodiversity awareness across society

Human life and civilizations depend on biodiversity. Therefore, the biodiversity crisis does not only threaten other species on genetic, species and ecosystem levels, but endangers us and our ways of life. Yet, awareness of the importance of biodiversity remains low and the understanding of the risks we are facing appears to be lacking.

The overarching impact aim of BIODIFUL is to facilitate the mainstreaming of biodiversity-respectful activity via individual, organisational, and societal leadership. This requires, first, that we increase and mainstream the awareness and understanding of the importance of biodiversity.

Biodiversity respectful leadership model for individuals

Individuals can initiate and lead change as consumers, citizens, professionals and activists. This requires the will to do the right things and knowledge of what the right things to do are.

BIODIFUL aims at creating knowledge about the links between our daily decisions and biodiversity impacts, especially concerning our choices about food and consumption. We also aim to do it in ways that inspire and empower individuals.

Biodiversity respectful leadership model for companies

Firms are the main instrument of both material wellbeing and environmental destruction. The question is how to hold on to the first achievement and transform the latter outcomes: due to their major impacts, firms must be at the forefront of the required change.
